The Currie Park Dome will not be operational this winter season, and several members will be looking into other possibilities for indoor flying.

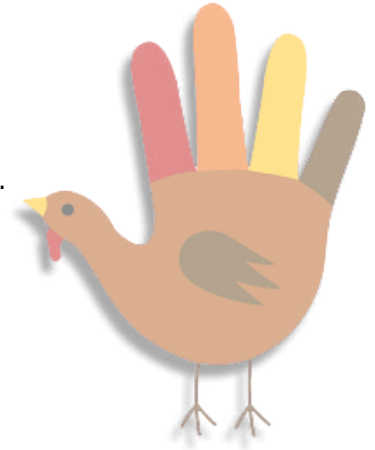
Elections-Elections for club officer positions will be held at the November membership meeting. All members are encouraged to come out and vote, and to serve as club officers.

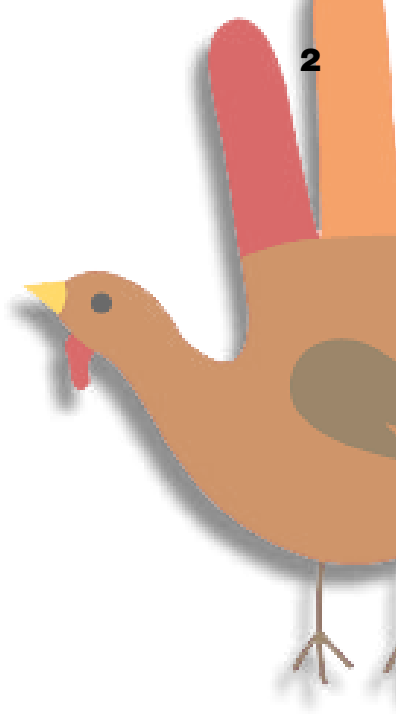


Check presented by Greg Markely to Scoutmaster Steve LeMaster of troop 840, funds will be used for Scouting trips and equipment.
