Treasurer's report – read and approved

Old/New business –

1. Lawn mower maintenance: approved for tune-up including pickup and delivery.
2. Looking for indoor golf cart winter storage: Richard Hustig offered to store it, Jeff Thompson offered to look for other options; need to decide within a week or two
3. Proposed flying field sun shelter, approximately 20 ft by 30 ft. Need someone to help with design ideas/sketches to show to We Energies. Greg to discuss design ideas with Tim from We Energies.
4. Milwaukee RC Association Report (Bob Ryan): last meeting on 11/3/18; 41st annual R/C Auction & Swap meet scheduled for Sunday, January 27, 2019. Laurie looking for volunteers to help run the swap meet (refer to event flyer).
5. Milwaukee RC Association providing grants to RC clubs for field improvements. Flying Electrons received \$500 for sun shelter and solar battery charging stations. The amount of the grant would be 25% of the project cost up to \$500. Peter to provide receipts and photos of the solar battery charging station to Bob Ryan. To be presented at the Milwaukee RC Association February 2019 meeting.
6. Next meeting December Christmas party: 1) as in prior years, please bring a dish to pass, 2) please RSVP Greg with what food you intend to bring.
7. Steve Tarney suggested raising club dues from \$50 to \$75. Astrowings dues are not in line with annual dues charged by other model RC airplane clubs. \$75 annual dues approved for 2019.
8. Fun Fly 2019: Greg requested help and support for creating a new and improved Fun Fly/Open House/Swap Meet; an open house may not require to be club sanctioned event (need to confirm); need someone to monitor flight line and confirm pilots that fly are members of AMA; need someone collect swap meet fee (\$ per vehicle); a few members needed to prepare and sell concessions; propose same date as last year.
9. Flying FPV: Club directors are in the process of amending the Field Rules to include FPV; tabled for future meeting
10. Club Officer Elections for 2019: Nominations accepted for Greg Williams for President, Tom Kunath for Vice President, Peter Pavelic for Secretary and Bob Lemon for Treasurer. Nominated officers approved.
