This month's club meeting is on December 17 at 7:30PM, at the Grafton Senior Center.


**From the President**

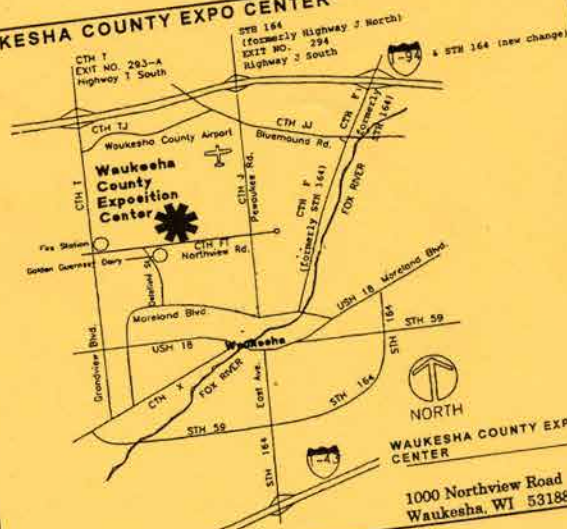
