The golf cart needs new seat cushions and a new backrest.

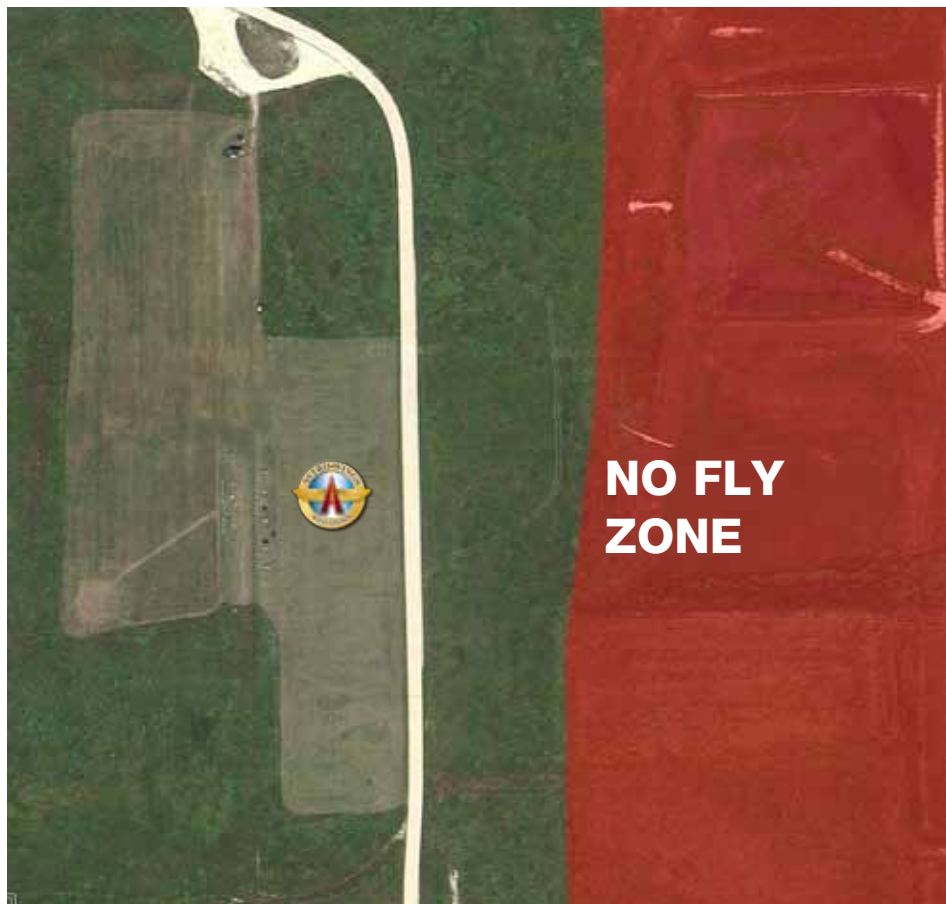
Repairs were voted on and approved.
