**Noah Pecor** continues the new member tradition of winning the airplane in the evenings raffle.



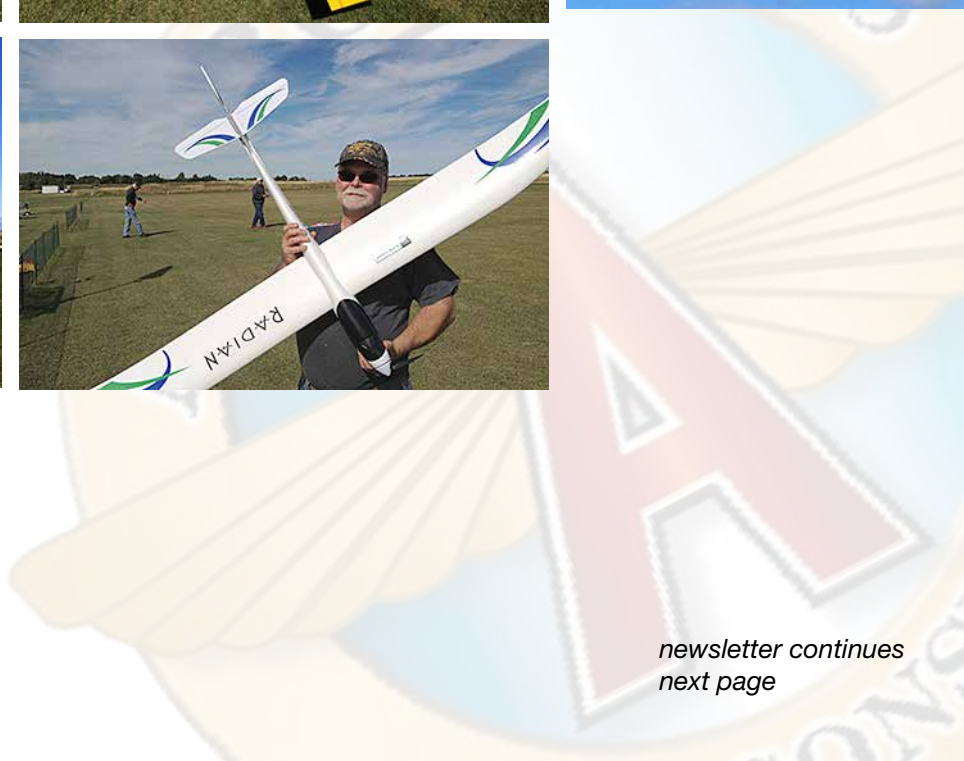
**Russ Whitford** is now fully prepared to take on any screw in the world. Just don't try taking those through a TSA inspection.
